## GETTING A ZOOM ACCOUNT

Getting a Zoom account is not necessary to join every meeting. If the person hosting the meeting allows it, anyone can join a meeting as long as they have the meeting ID number. However, due to the rise in “Zoom bombing” - pranking or doing malicious things during a Zoom meeting - many hosts are now requiring the participants to have a Zoom account.

You can sign up for a Zoom account for free. There are some limitations to the free accounts, though. Group meetings that you host are limited to 40 minutes with no more than 100 participants and the recording feature is disabled.

Just a note of warning - Zoom hasn't had the best security record in the past. The security on the phone and tablet apps is worse than on the computer browser version. So if you are worried about security, use Zoom on your computer.

### **Signing up in a browser:**

Go to [zoom.us](https://zoom.us) and click this button in the top right corner and follow the prompts to enter your birth date and email.

### **Signing up with a mobile app:**

Download and install the ZOOM Cloud Meetings app. Click “Sign Up” and follow the prompts to enter your birth date and email.

You will get a confirmation email with a link to click on which will activate your account. You will then be asked to enter your name and create a password.

Once you do this, you will be ready to go.



If you are using a work or school account, the Admin section where you can control the account settings will not appear. Your company or school will appoint an administrator to handle that.


