

BATH SALTS CRAFT KIT

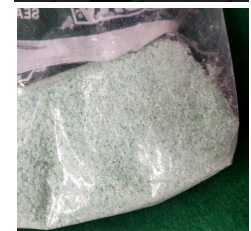
Materials Included

Jar with lid
Bag of epsom salts
Fragrance oil
Concentrated soap color
Cornstarch (optional)



Be careful with the colorant. The liquid is very concentrated and can stain clothes and skin if it drips.

Unzip the bag containing the salt.
Place 3-7 drops of color onto the salt.
Add 10 - 15 drops of fragrance oil.



Re-zip bag and shake until the color is thoroughly mixed.
If the color is not strong enough, open the bag & add a few more drops, then shake again.

Optional step: Unzip the bag and add the cornstarch.
Close bag and shake until thoroughly mixed.
Coating the bath salt with cornstarch will keep it from clumping up in your humid bathroom. It will also add a silky feel to your bathwater. This step will lighten the color a little because the cornstarch is white, so be prepared for a more pastel look.

Pour finished bath salts into jar and close lid.
Use 1/4-1/2 jar per bath.
