

Materials

Wooden stick, 10"

Beading Wire, 4 pieces, 35"

Beads

Hanging cord

Large jingle bells, 4

Small jingle bells, 4

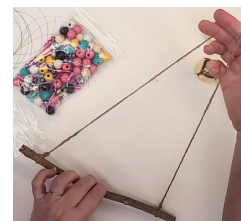


You will need to provide a pair of scissors.

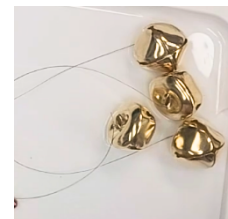
You might want to work on a baking sheet to keep the beads from rolling away.

Instructions

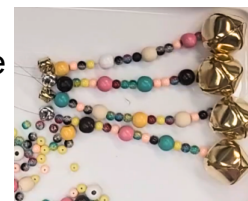
Tie the ends of the hanging cord about 1" from the ends of the stick.



Tie a large jingle bell to the end of each beading wire. Add a couple of extra knots for strength.



Add beads to the wires until you have about 5-6" on each one. I have used a 3 small, 1 large pattern here. Add a small bell to each strand.



Continue adding beads until you have about 14-15" of beads on each strand.



Tie the strands onto the wooden stick, spacing them out evenly about 1 1/2" apart. Tie a couple of extra knots for strength.



Thread the tail end down through a few beads to hide it. Trim off the excess.



Hang your wind chime over a branch or a hook where it will get a lot of wind.
